Blue Ribbon Hall & The Captain's Courtyard

Take a step back in time as you enter Blue Ribbon Hall, the corporate VIP center of the historic Pabst Brewery. This German beer hall-style space comes complete with an outdoor courtyard that we call "Captain's Courtyard", a second-story balcony, hand-painted fresco murals, iron chandeliers, hand-blown glass windows, and hand-carved decorative wood trim.

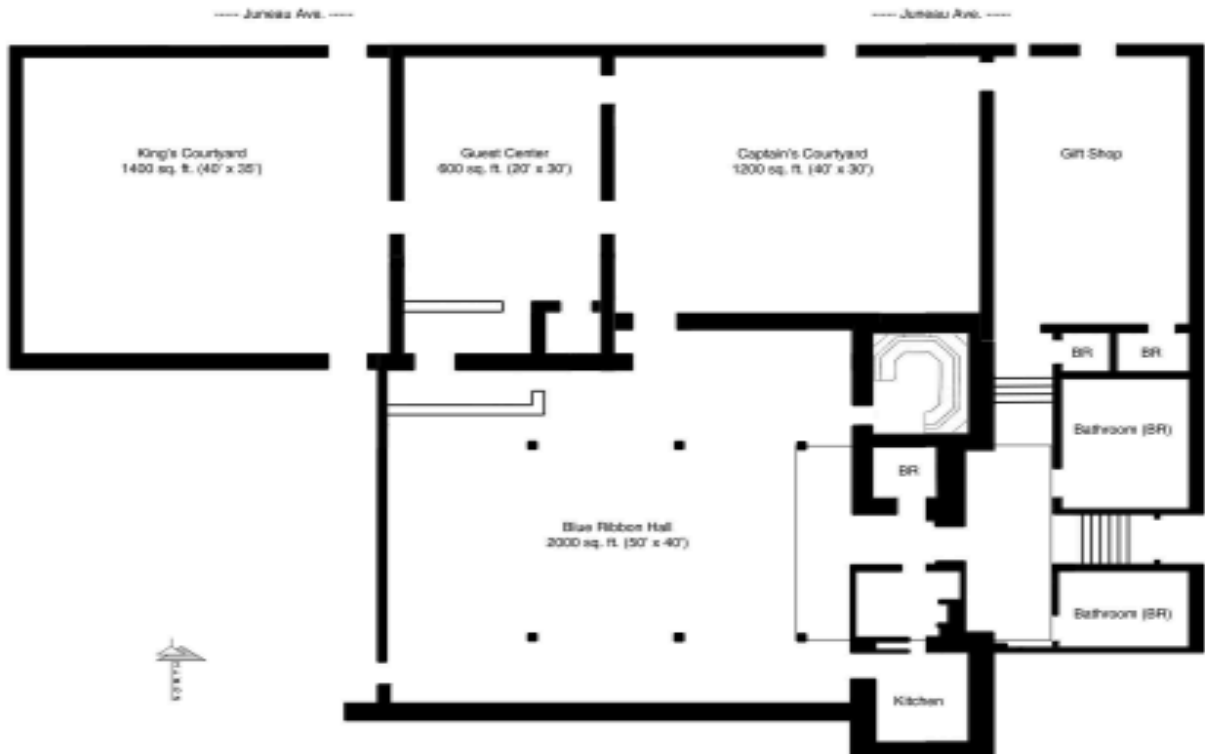

The Great Hall & Speakeasy

923 W Juneau Ave. Milwaukee WI

Built in 1880, The Great Hall was the original corporate headquarters of the Pabst Brewery. This space includes Frederick Pabst's office, the prohibition-themed "Speakeasy" bar, original stained-glass windows, original woodwork, and cream city brick exterior.

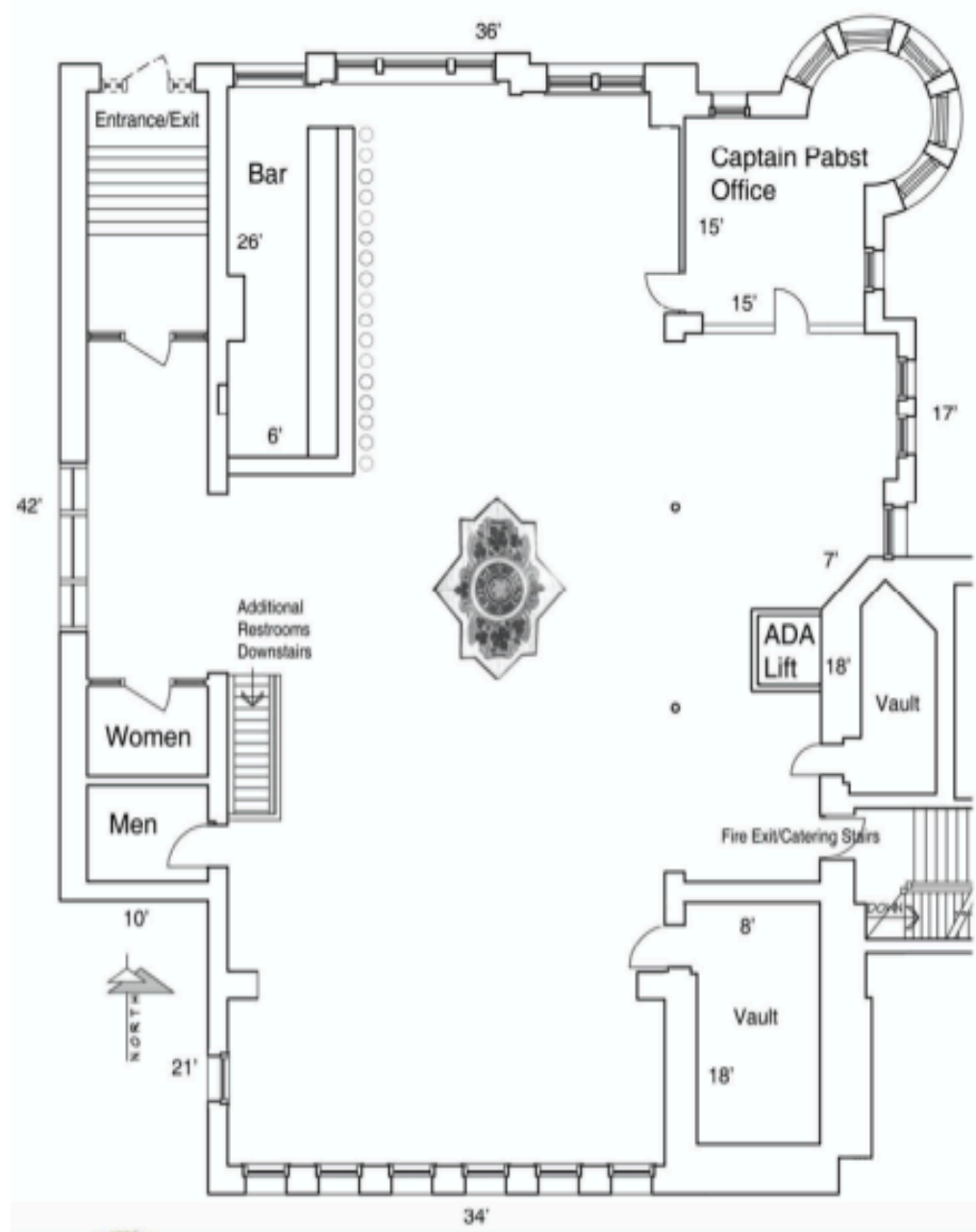

Beverage Information

We have very reasonable beverage pricing, and we don't have rigid drink packages. We like to let you customize a bar package for your event. On average, when events host beer, wine, and soft drinks, the price per person is about \$35. When cocktails are added to that, the price per person goes up to about \$50 for rail (Absolut, Tanqueray, Bacardi, Jose Cuervo, Seagrams 7, and Christian Brothers brandy) and about \$70 for a full open bar including premium/top shelf liquors. We do not have a minimum purchase requirement for private event rentals.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is a deposit required?

Yes, a deposit of 25% is required to secure a date immediately. The full balance is due 60 days prior to the event.

How early can we get into the venue?

Typically between 2-2:30pm, though depending on the circumstances we may be able to offer earlier entry.

When can we drop off decorations?

We allow drop-offs the day prior to the event during regular business hours.

When do we have to be cleared out?

We won't boot you out the door when your event ends, though we do ask that you leave within one hour of the end of the contracted event.

Is the venue ADA compliant?

Yes, we are fully ADA compliant. Passageways are 33" wide or more, restrooms are ADA compliant, and the elevator lift is 39" x 60".

What is your cancellation policy?

We will keep the non-refundable 25% deposit per the contract. A sample contract is available upon request.

Are there bar minimums or bar packages?

No, our bar operates on a consumption basis. We don't have a required minimum purchase, and we don't have rigid drink packages. We like to let you customize a bar package for your event. We can give you examples and a better explanation of a consumption based package upon request.

How many bartenders will you staff?

We staff one bartender per 40 guests.

Is there an on-site caterer?

We do not have an in-house caterer, but we do have an approved list of caterers that we love to work with.

How far in advance must we book your services?

We suggest as soon as possible, we're not a very well kept secret anymore.



Frequently Asked Questions Continued

Do you provide a sound system or A/V?

Yes, we can provide microphones, HD projector and screen, and speakers. Sound production for weddings is not provided.

Are there restrictions on decorations?

Items are not to be placed on the walls or hung from the ceilings (we suggest the use of easels which we can provide). All displays located within Best Place cannot be changed or removed. The use of glitter, confetti, sequins, sequins-confetti or tinsel is prohibited. Tape, nails, tacks & staples are prohibited. Only enclosed candles are permitted. Fogging and bubble machines are not allowed. No candles, glass vases nor lanterns are allowed on the floor.

What is the parking situation for guests?

There is street parking available in front of the venue and in the surrounding Brewery District neighborhood. There is also a parking garage across the street managed by Interstate Parking, you can reserve spaces with that company.

Is there a hotel nearby?

Yes, there are four hotels close to Best Place. The Brewhouse Inn & Suites, and Hyatt Place Downtown are both located within one block of Best Place. The Trade Hotel and Aloft are both in close proximity as well.

Could other events be scheduled the same day?

Yes, we do have beer history tours but they will not conflict with any hall rental event start time. There also may be another event in a different venue.
